Election Quick Guide**

Fees:

- A qualification fee of 1% of the annual salary of the office sought shall be paid
 \$100 Mayor \$80 Commissioner
- An election assessment fee in accordance with F.S. § 99.093 of 1% of the annual salary of the office sought shall be paid
 \$100 Mayor \$80 Commissioner
- Any person seeking election who is unable to pay the election assessment fee without imposing an undue burden shall, upon written certification of such inability given under oath to the qualifying officer, be exempt from paying the election assessment.

Petition Cards:

- 150 qualified voters with fee
- 1% of the total registered voters of the city as of the most recent preceding regular city election to avoid fee
