Effective July 1st, 2011, Golf Carts will be allowed in the City of Dunedin on many of our streets as an alternative mode of transportation. Please see the reverse side for a map of the permitted roadways.



What are the rules?

- ✓ All golf carts must be registered by the City of Dunedin
- ✓ Driver must possess a valid Driver License
- ✓ Driver must obey all rules of the road
- ✓ Operator Manual to be distributed with registration of vehicle



What equipment do I need?

- ✓ Efficient brakes
- ✓ Reliable steering
- ✓ Horn
- ✓ Safe tires
- ✓ Rearview mirror
- ✓ Red reflectorized warning devices (front/rear)
- ✓ If driven between the hours of sunset and sunrise, headlights, brake lights, turn signals, and a windshield are also required

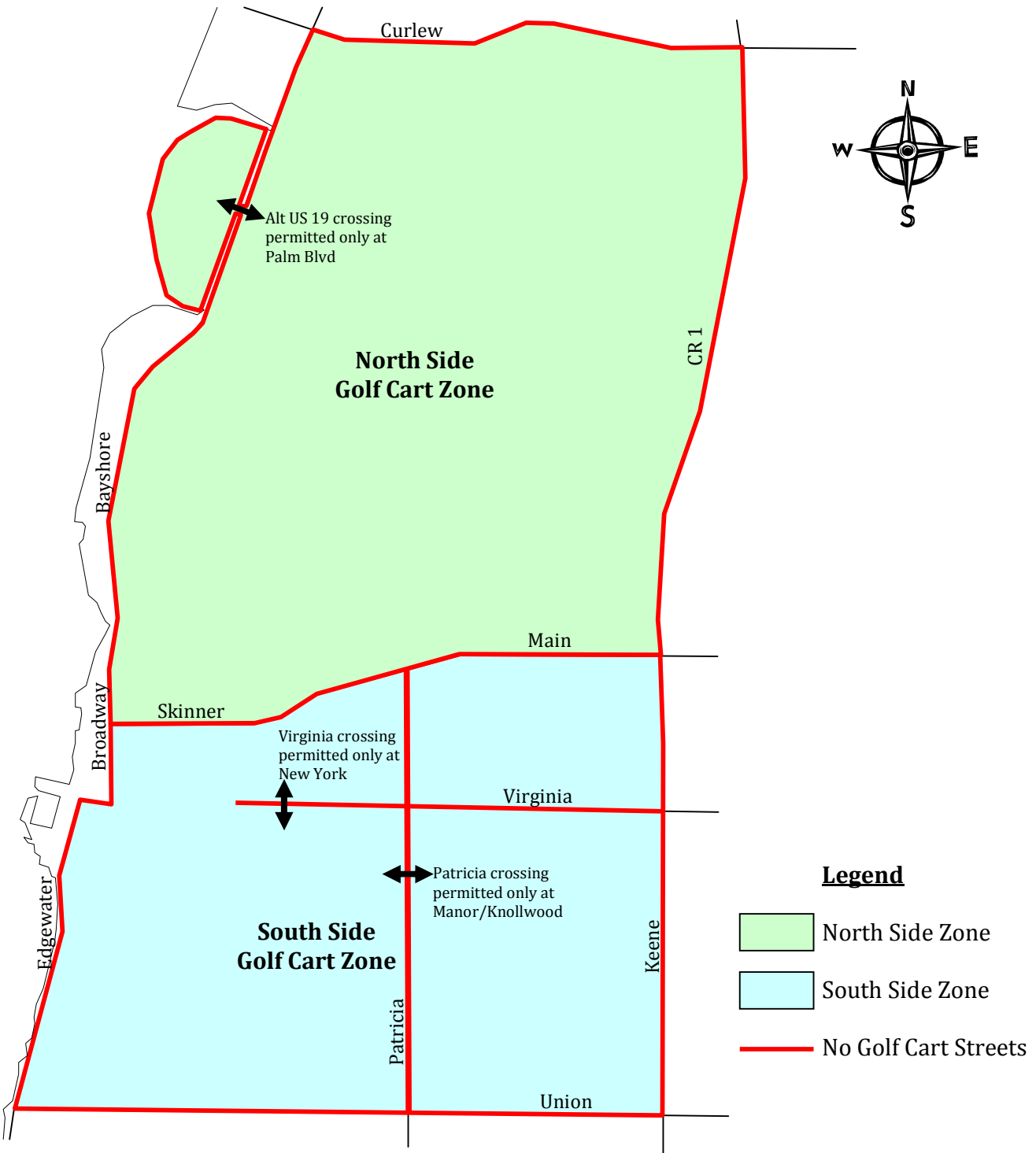
