

STORMWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Applications are being accepted from Dunedin residents for consideration of appointment to the City's Stormwater Advisory Committee (SAC) to address the needs and concerns of the City stormwater system and its environmental impacts on City drainage basins and local waterways. The committee will be comprised of 5 members representing a cross-section of the community by drainage basin. Those drainage basins include Curlew Creek, Cedar Creek, Spring Branch (Stevenson's Creek), Coastal Drainage Basin and Brick Yard Creek (vicinity of Weaver Park), along with 4 at-large members. This committee will also be augmented with single representation from the Committee on Environmental Quality, Causeway and Coastal Waterways Committee, and the Friends of the Hammock Park.

Applications are to be submitted by Friday, June 5th, 2009 with the expectation that the City Commission will consider candidate appointment at their regularly scheduled meeting of June 18th, 2009. The first meeting of the Stormwater Advisory Committee is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, June 30th at 6:30 PM at the Dunedin Reverse Osmosis Water Plant at 1405 County Road One. Future meeting dates and times will be determined by the SAC membership.

Attached for your information is a copy of enabling Resolution 09-14, a drainage basin map of Dunedin, and an application form. If interested, please complete an application and forward to Geri Guegan, City Clerk at P.O. Box 1348, Dunedin, FL 34697-1348, or hand deliver to her office at the Municipal Services Building at 750 Milwaukee Avenue. If you cannot determine the drainage basin in which you live, the City will gladly make that determination on your behalf and will identify such on your submitted application.
