Gifts as tributes or memorials bespeak the high regard for those so honored. They are the ultimate in kindness from a thoughtful friend.



Dunedin Public Library is the oldest library in Pinellas County. Library service began in Dunedin in 1895 with the donation by Christopher Bouton of 200 books from his personal collection. A donation of over \$1.3 million by Franklin Chase Milliken in 1990 was the impetus to build our Library. Donations did, indeed, turn the tide of events during the first century of library activities in Dunedin.

In order to excel in the third century of service it is essential the assets of your fine Library facility be abundantly nurtured.


