Pinellas County is conducting a “Public Alternatives Workshop” for the Dunedin Causeway Bridges PD&E Study on March 29, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. at the Hale Community Center in Dunedin.

Potential rehabilitation or replacement of the two bridges within the project limits has been evaluated. Viable alternatives have been developed based on engineering and environmental analysis and community input.
