

# *Golf Cart Transportation*

*Per City Ordinance 2011-04, Golf Carts are now allowed in the City of Dunedin on designated streets as an alternative mode of transportation. Please see the map of the permitted roadways.*



## What are the rules?

- ✓ All golf carts must be registered by the City of Dunedin
- ✓ Driver must possess a valid Driver License
- ✓ Driver must obey all rules of the road
- ✓ Operator Manual to be distributed with registration of vehicle

## What equipment do I need?

- ✓ Efficient brakes
- ✓ Reliable steering
- ✓ Horn
- ✓ Safe tires
- ✓ Rearview mirror
- ✓ Red reflectorized warning devices (front/rear)
- ✓ If driven between the hours of sunset and sunrise, headlights, brake lights, turn signals, and a windshield are also required
