19-2HP – Request for Local Historic Landmark Designation (Private Residence). Property located at 645 Loudon Avenue.

19-3HP – Request for Local Historic Landmark Designation (Blatchley House). Property located at 232 Lee Street.

19-4HP – Request for Local Historic Landmark Designation (Andrews Memorial Chapel). Property located at 1899 San Mateo Drive.

Interested parties may appear at the hearing on the date noted above and be heard with respect to the application. This application will be available for public viewing at the Office of Planning, 1415 Pinehurst Road, during normal business hours. All persons are hereby advised that any presentation they make will be encouraged to be as concise as possible and may be limited to permit maximum participation by the public at large. Any person who decides to appeal any decision with respect to any matter considered at this hearing will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based per Florida Statute 286.0105.
