Project Title: The Leland Chase Outdoor Gallery Wall

Project Theme: "Celebrating Diversity"

Total Budget: \$4,000. (Includes <u>up to</u> 14 artist licensing fees of \$100. each plus materials, fabrication, installation and ID plaques)

Deadline for Submission (Email Only): Received by 2:00 pm Wednesday, February 7, 2024

Eligibility: Open to professional and student artists who legally reside in Pinellas County.

Funding Partners: The Funding partner is the City of Dunedin and The Dunedin Public Art Fund.

- The City of Dunedin Arts & Culture Advisory Committee (ACAC) is requesting submission of art work for public display to be installed on the Leland Chase Outdoor Gallery Wall at Dunedin Wastewater Center, 1140 Martin Luther King Jr Ave. Up to 14 artworks may be selected for 4' x 6' mural-like display.
- New or existing works in any 2D media (including photography, painting, digital, drawings, print, etc.) that support the theme can be submitted.
- Works shall be initially submitted as digital images not to exceed 1 MB. The best digital file formats for large prints are **TIFF** and **PDF**. Name the image file: the email shall include the digital image titled with artist surname and title of work (for example, Picasso-Guernica.jpg).

Please note that if selected, artists must provide a final image file either a vector art (pdf), or a rastered flat file at least 150 dpi Full Size, or 300 dpi Half Size.

- In the body of the email: artist's name, any art affiliations, e-mail, phone number, address and title of work. If the artwork is selected, a high-resolution photo shall be provided by the artist for printing.
- Images will be reviewed and selected by the Leland Chase Outdoor Gallery Subcommittee, a subcommittee of the Arts & Culture Advisory Committee. Preference will be given to Dunedin residents.

- Selected artists will be paid a \$100. licensing fee for use of the digital image(s) of their original artwork(s). A maximum of two images per artist can be submitted. The artist will retain the original work and it may be offered for sale by the artist. Only six-fourteen artist finalists may be offered this fee for one mural each.
