**Per the City Charter, Section 5.03 The Mayor and Commissioners for Seats 1 & 3 will serve a four (4) year term**, commencing the second (2nd) Monday following the election (*Special Meeting, November 18, 2024*).

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**Pursuant to the Dunedin City Charter, Section 5.01, Elections**, “All persons qualified to vote as an elector of this State, under the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Florida, who reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of Dunedin, and who are duly registered on the registration books of Pinellas County shall be qualified electors of the City of Dunedin in all elections except as otherwise provided by law.”

**Further, pursuant to the Dunedin City Code, Sec. 26-73, Method of qualifying**, “As a condition precedent to qualifying, the candidates shall be required to file with their petition cards personal affidavits showing that they are residents of the city, having physically resided therein for a period of at least one year immediately prior to submitting the petition cards and are qualified electors of the City.”

**WHO MAY VOTE  
IN THE  
NOVEMBER 5, 2024  
MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

To vote, you must be registered 29 days before the election. **HOWEVER**, if you are a **NEW RESIDENT** in the City of Dunedin, but are moving within the state of Florida, you will still be eligible to vote in the November 5, 2024, election by filing your new address, with proof, at your polling location.

The statewide Florida Voter Registration System allows a registered voter to change his/her address within the state by notifying the Supervisor of Elections of an address change by phone or email and providing the voter's date of birth, and Florida DL/ID number or the last four digits of the voter's social security number.

**ALL** Dunedin Elected Officials are elected at large, which means: All registered voters within the corporate limits of the City of Dunedin, are eligible to vote for the Mayor, the Commissioner for Seat 1 and the Commissioner for Seat 3.

**For Your Information:** Both photo and signature identification will be required at the polling place for all elections.
