## **RESOLUTION 23-09**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FL, ADOPTING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE FOR AD VALOREM TAX REVENUE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 AT A RATE NOT TO EXCEED 4.1345 MILLS OR \$4.13 PER \$1,000.00 OF ASSESSED PROPERTY VALUE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC HEARING DATES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City is required to adopt the millage rate in accordance with the procedures set forth in section 200.065, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission not to exceed the maximum rate of 4.1345 mills or a millage rate of \$4.13 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property value for ad valorem tax revenue for the coming Fiscal Year 2023-24; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has set the Public Hearing dates for the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Final Millage Rate and Final Operating and Capital Budget to be held in City Hall, City Commission Chambers on Wednesday, September 6, 2023 at 5:01 p.m. and Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.; now therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY ASSEMBLED, THAT:

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true, correct, and incorporated by reference as if set forth fully herein.

**Section 2.** The proposed millage rate for ad valorem taxes for the City of Dunedin, Florida for Fiscal Year 2024 shall not exceed 4.1345 mills.

**Section 3.** The Public Hearings on the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget are hereby established as Wednesday, September 6, 2023 at 5:01 p.m. and Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in City Hall, City Commission Chambers where interested parties may appear and address the City Commission on these issues.

**Section 4.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
