Dunedin Parks & Recreation Summer Camp Registration 2023

Summer Camp registration begins at 8:00 am on Wednesday, March 8, 2023 at the <u>Dunedin Community Center</u> or online at <u>www.DunedinGov.com/registeronline</u>. You may also register at the <u>MLK Jr. Recreation Center</u> (after 2:00 pm). All prerequisites listed below must be fulfilled prior to registering. Both residents and non-residents may enroll in summer camps. Registration will continue until camps are full.

Prerequisites:

- You must have a valid, up-to-date account prior to registration. New accounts are created <u>online</u> or in person at the Dunedin Community Center or the MLK, Jr. Recreation Center. Photo ID and Proof of Residency is required.
- A Signed or E-Authorized <u>Comprehensive Waiver</u> is required for all participants. Camp registration forms must be completed in full (NO BLANK FIELDS) for each child, and **all waivers and forms must be completed and authorized by the Parent or Legal Guardian ONLY.** Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
- New forms can only be submitted on or after March 1 on a yearly basis.
- For children enrolled in our 2022-2023 Before and After School Care Program, parents will only need to update, verify and sign their current forms (in person) on or after March 1, prior to registering for camps.
- Full payment for all desired camp weeks is suggested to ensure your child's spot in camp.

Recreation Cards:

A Recreation Card (Rec Card) is not required but it gives the card holder discounted rates. Non-Residents and Unincorporated purchasers should calculate whether or not buying a Rec Card is cost effective when factoring in the number of weeks children are attending camp. Rec Cards are purchased per person and must be valid through the last day of the activity for which the member is enrolled. If a Rec Card is not purchased, the higher "no card" rate will apply.

Recreation Card Rates:

- a. Resident Rec Card: \$10/year. A driver's license **and** proof of residency (current document such as a utility bill, property tax statement or insurance statement) are required.
- b. Non-Resident Rec Card: \$90/year or \$56/six months. A driver's license is required.
- c. Unincorporated Rec Card (Pinellas County): \$56/year. A driver's license and proof of residency are required.

Note: The Inter-Local Agreement for Oldsmar, Tarpon Springs and Safety Harbor residents excludes child camps.

Enrollment Information:

1. Browse the <u>Summer Camp Magazine</u> to choose your desired camps.

2. All form and waiver prerequisites must be fulfilled (see Prerequisites above). Forms are available at the Community Center, MLK Jr. Recreation Center, or can be printed online at Forms & Applications | (www.dunedingov.com).

- a) To register your child in person:
 Submit forms and complete the Parent Worksheet by circling the corresponding dot in the column of the camp(s) in which you would like to enroll your child. Use one worksheet per child.
- b) To complete registration online: Upload Forms under the "My Documents" tab while logged in and check email for approved status. Form and Residency review may take up to 3 business days. Camp spots are NOT held during this time. If you want to guarantee your child's enrollment, we encourage you to enroll in person. IMPORTANT: To efficiently handle and review online forms, the ability to submit forms online will not be available after Sunday, March 5 at 9:00 pm and will reopen on Monday, March 13 at 8:00 am.
- 3. Purchase a Rec Card for discounted rates (if desired).
- 4. Payment forms include cash, check, VISA, MasterCard, Discover and American Express.
