Boat Ramp Pay Kiosk - Since the start of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Marina and boat ramp have been busier than ever. The addition of a credit card kiosk at the boat ramp has provided a convenient alternative for customers to pay their boat launching fees.

Marina Repairs - Marina staff continue with repairs and improvement projects such as the installation of new pedestals, securement of finger dock boards on all of the 25 and 30 foot slips and daily maintenance.

Manatees - We are all happy to see that the manatees have returned, some with calves alongside. Please proceed with caution as you motor through the Marina and the waters throughout St. Joseph Sound.

Covid-19 - Please remember that face masks are mandatory when entering all City Buildings, this includes the Harbormaster's Office.

Parking and Ramp Permits - All 2020 permits have expired. Please be sure to renew expired ramp and parking permits in order to avoid parking tickets. 2021 permits are available in the Marina office. 2020 boat ramp permit holders receive a 25% discount upon renewal.

Online Slip Rental Payments - We encourage everyone to set up payments though your online banking. This will helps to avoid late fees and will keep inperson contact to a minimum due to Covid-19. You will need to reference the eight digit account number that is located on your invoice when setting up online payments through your bank. Checks can also be deposited in the drop box outside of the office door.

Hurricane Preparedness Week

is May 9-15, 2021.

- Check hurricane supplies and order what you need before the demand exceeds what is available.
- The pandemic continues to create shortages of all types of merchandise, don't expect supplies to be available.
- A thorough inspection of lines, chafing gear, etc. should be conducted.
- If you have a trailer, have it ready for hauling should a storm present a threat to our area.

Hurricane Season begins June 1st and ends on November 30th.

- If you will not be available to secure your vessel during storm preparations, please provide the Marina office with the contact information of an alternate designee.
- Please monitor email communications from the Marina. If you change your email address, please notify us so that we can update your file.

Safety First

Shore Power Cords should be disconnected from the pedestal when not in use and the breakers turned off. Cords should never be touching the water.

Extra Cleats are available if your slip needs one. The upright boards are not intended for securing vessels. Please send us an email letting us know where you would like it and one will be installed.

Secure Your Vessels before you leave the marina. Please make sure that anything of value is secured or removed from your vessel when not in use.
