2022 Slip Renter Parking & Annual Boat Ramp Permits

2021 Parking and Ramp permits are now expired. Please remember to stop by the marina office and pick up your 2022 permits as soon as possible. These are \$5 each and only available to slip renters. The Annual Boat Ramp permit fees are \$75 for Dunedin residents and \$225 for non-residents.

At the request of slip renters, the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office has increased permitted parking patrols, including the trailer parking area. As per the Marina Rules & Regulations, the permit decals must be affixed to the vehicle on the passenger side rear window or bumper, where they are the most visible to law enforcement.

Extended Slip Vacancies:

Please remember to notify the Marina office if your vessel will be out of the slip for more than a week. The extended absence form can be found on our website and emailed to the Harbormaster.

Marina Maintenance:

Please notify us with any questions, comments, concerns or maintenance needs. Safety is always our priority and we appreciate the extra eyes and input of our slip renters.

The water line and hose connections along the west wall have been replaced. We ask that everyone please disconnect their hoses and store them either in their dock box or on the boat when not in use. This will prevent unauthorized use of hoses belonging to vessel owners.
