Safety

- Gate security is lost once the codes are given out. Locked gates are for security of all persons and vessels, so please do not share the codes. Please meet guests at the gate for access and do not let others follow you through unless you know them.
- Shore power cords should be inspected regularly and replaced when necessary. Cords that are altered from their original manufactured configuration are not permitted. Household extension cords are not approved for marine use and will be disconnected by marina staff. Please visit www.marinco.com for further information regarding marine grade shore power cords.

Marina Updates

- Maintenance is ongoing throughout the year. Please report any issues you may see to the office so that we can get it taken care of as quickly as possible.
- Insurance declaration pages must be provided to the office each year upon renewal. Lapses in insurance are not permitted.
- Bilge socks are available in the marina office if you need a couple while performing vessel maintenance.
- **Expired flares** may be brought to the Harbormaster's office for disposal.
- Marina fire extinguishers are inspected each year at this time. We encourage vessel owners to check theirs at this time as well.
- North wall water lines have been replaced.
- Abandoned vessel removal: We are experiencing delays in removing damaged/abandoned vessels due to the large volume of Florida vessels needing to be hauled away. Please continue to use caution while navigating.
- Manatees have been frequent visitors in the marina, so keep a close eye out for them as you come and go from your slips. Many people are unaware that it is illegal to touch, feed or provide them with water from hoses. This encourages them to look to humans for food and water, putting them in further danger of being injured by propellers.
