Safety

- Gate codes are being used by people other than vessel owners. Therefore, it is necessary to change the codes. The new codes will be sent via email, so please be sure we have your correct email address. Please check your spam folder if you are not receiving our communications and add us to your safe sender list. Locked gates are for security of all persons and vessels, so please do not share the codes. Guests must be accompanied by vessel owners and should be met at the gate for access. Don't let others follow you onto the docks unless you know them.
- Shore power cords should be inspected regularly and replaced when necessary. Cords that are altered from their original manufactured configuration are not permitted. Household extension cords are not approved for marine use.

Marina Maintenance/Projects

- **Electric Service Panel Replacement Update** - The replacement of equipment supplying power to the marina has begun. The replacement of the equipment that services the pier has been completed. By the end of January, replacement of the service equipment located in Edgewater Park will begin. This equipment powers Docks B and C, and the south and west walls, plus the Boat Club and Sailing Center. Power will be out for approximately 5 days, and email notices will be sent once we have confirmed a date for disconnection with Duke Energy and the contractor. We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your while this patience necessary improvement is made to the marina. Dock A equipment will be scheduled for replacement once backordered materials have been received by the contractor. Dock A vessel owners will be notified once a date is confirmed.
- Maintenance is ongoing throughout the year. Please report any issues you may see to the office so that we can get it taken care of as quickly as possible.
- **Spill Kits** are available for fuel/chemical spills in the basin. The kits are bright yellow and are located next to the Sailing Center and at Slip #3 on the north wall.
