Slip Fee Increase



On March 9, 2023, the City Commission approved a 10% rate increase for marina slip usage fees. The fee increase will take effect beginning on April 1, 2023. The new rate will be included in the statement mailed to customers on approximately March 22nd.

As a friendly reminder, please be mindful of updating payment amounts that are set up through your bank's automated online bill pay system.

Marina Reminders

- **Vessels must be operable at all times.**
- **Every vessel with a head** must be equipped with a permanently installed and properly functioning USCG approved marine sanitation device.
- **Maintenance** is ongoing throughout the year. Please report issues directly to the marina office to ensure that staff is aware and can respond to maintenance needs as quickly as possible.
- **Address and contact information changes** must be emailed to the Harbormaster so our records can be updated.

Red tide is affecting the waters along the Pinellas County coastline. Marina staff, along with the help of some very kind volunteers, have been working hard to remove as many of the fish as possible each day from the marina basin.
