## Storm Season

Hurricane Season is quickly approaching, as well as increased thunderstorm activity. Many lessons were learned from last season, the most important of which is to never let your guard down. The one that we most fear is not necessarily the one that will cause the most damage.

Whether it is a hurricane or “just an afternoon thunderstorm”, please be prepared and check your boat frequently.

- Conduct a thorough inspection of lines, chafing gear, etc. regularly.
- Order supplies ahead of the season while supply chains are still stocked.
- Keep boat trailers well maintained and ready for use in case a storm threatens our area.
- Assign an alternate person to be responsible for securing your vessel in the event that you are not available. Provide the Marina office with their contact information. Monitor all email communications from the Marina and the City, and add both to your safe sender list. If you change your email address, send us an email notification so our records are up-to-date.

## Pram Shed Replacement

The demolition and construction of the Pram Shed on the west side of the marina has been awarded to Qualis General Contractors. The project will begin next month. We will email the start date and further details as soon information becomes available.



## Buying A Boat?

### Selling your boat or buying a new one?

Please be sure to contact the Marina office for information prior to making your purchase. The new boat must fit the requirements for the slip.



Staff is often asked if there are any boats for sale in the marina. If you would like us to pass the vessel information on to potential buyers, please send us an email with details.

## Marina Reminders

**Vessels must** be kept operable and in safe, seaworthy, well-maintained, and presentable condition at all times.

**No hazardous or flammable liquids** are permitted to be stored on any docks within the marina. Fuels carried upon the docks must be in DOT, UL or FM approved containers and the contents clearly marked.

**Maintenance** is ongoing throughout the year. Please report issues directly to the marina office to ensure that staff is aware and can respond to maintenance needs as quickly as possible.

**Cars without marina permits** that occupy ‘permit only’ spaces can be reported to the Pinellas County Sheriff’s Office by calling the non-emergency line at 727-582-6200.
