Boat Parade Information

- No overnight parking will be permitted on Friday, December 6th. Deputies will attempt to contact owners of vehicles illegally parked,, If the owner can't be reached, the vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense.
- The north entrance (Marina Plaza) will be closed from 6 a.m. 11 p.m.
- The south entrance will remain open until 4 p.m.
- The church lot will not be available for trailer parking. Once trailer spaces are full, the ramp will be closed.
- If parking by the clubhouse, park only in marked spaces (including golf carts).
 No parking along the seawall. This will be enforced to allow access for emergency vehicles and for pedestrian safety.
- Vehicles will not be permitted to leave until after the Tree Lighting Ceremony has concluded.

Important Updates Beach Ramp Construction

The new beach ramp is finished and ready for use! This ramp is intended for small, non-motorized watercraft only, such as prams, kayaks, and paddleboards that are launched without the use of a trailer.

Marina Dredging and Dock A

The process for getting the dredging project put out to bid is moving along. We are aiming for the project to begin some time during late spring to summer. Dock A renovation is being submitted for permitting. The dates for construction are still to be determined. We will keep you updated as we receive more information.

A few friendly reminders to help keep our marina clean:

- Please keep all personal items on your vessel or stored in your dock boxes.
 See the Rules and Regulations for approved dock box specifications prior to purchasing.
- The trash receptacles throughout the marina are intended for small items. Larger items such as boxes or bags of trash, should be taken to the dumpster located at the northeast corner of the parking lot near Edgewater Park. No trash is to be left outside of the trash cans.
