Marina Updates

- **Thank you!** We truly appreciate your diligence during recent storms and extreme tidal conditions. Storm preparations are vital in avoiding significant damage to the marina and the vessels.
- **North wall water line replacement:** Water lines along the north wall will be replaced later this month, weather and tides permitting. There will be temporary service interruptions to perform the work. Affected customers will be given sufficient notice once we receive the schedule from the contractor. We appreciate your understanding as we make these improvements.
- **Abandoned vessels:** Law enforcement agencies and the USCG have been alerted to several vessels outside of the marina basin which are either partially or completely submerged due to recent storms. These vessels will be removed as soon as possible, so please continue to use caution while navigating.
- **Security camera installation** has been completed. Please contact the Harbormaster's office if you have any questions regarding the security camera system.

Friendly Reminders

- **Vessels with heads** must be equipped with a permanently installed, properly functioning, USCG-approved sanitation device. Heads will be subject to scheduled inspections with sufficient notice to slip users.
- **Thank you** to all of you who are disconnecting your hoses while not in use. In order to prevent corrosion, Marina staff will continue to disconnect any hoses that are left connected to spigots. Please store the hose on the vessel or in your dock box when not in use.
- **Larger trash items** such as cardboard boxes, must be thrown in the dumpster, not into or next to the marina trash cans.
