Marina Updates

- Repair of damages caused by Hurricane Idalia are still ongoing. We appreciate your patience while we continue to schedule repairs and improvements.
- The construction of the new Sailing Center is entering the final stages and will be opening soon. Please stay tuned for future updates!
- Manatees are frequently visiting the marina basin and surrounding areas. Please continue to use caution and keep an eye out for them as you navigate to and from your slip.

Did you know....?

- Anyone performing work within the marina must first have a certificate of insurance on file in the marina office, and sign in at the office prior to beginning work. This includes divers, detailers, mechanics, electricians, a/c repair, fuel delivery, etc. This is for the protection of ALL vessel owners. Please refer to the Marina Rules and Regulations for further details at marina-rules-and-regulatio.pdf (dunedingov.com)
- Shore power cords should never be wrapped around the shore power pedestal. This is a common problem in marinas causing pedestals to be pulled free from the dock and power connection. In an effort to keep the cord out of the water, the slack should be adjusted on the vessel instead of at the pedestal.
