Marina Project Updates

- **Replacement of the fire suppression pipes** on Docks A, B and C has been completed. Thank you for your patience.
- **Installation of security cameras** throughout the marina is currently underway. Pending delivery of a few backordered items, the contractor hopes to have the project completed in the next few weeks.
- **North wall water line replacement:** We hope to schedule this project for October and will notify affected slip users with further information when it becomes available.
- **Marina Electrical Upgrades Project:** Materials for this project have been ordered by the contractor. Delays in product availability are expected. Marina staff will send updates as information becomes available.

Friendly Reminders

- Please update the marina office immediately with any changes in your contact information.
- Vessels with heads must be equipped with a permanently installed, properly functioning, USCG-approved sanitation device. Heads will be subject to scheduled inspections with sufficient notice to slip users.
- Thank you to all of you who are disconnecting your hoses while not in use. In order to prevent corrosion, Marina staff will continue to disconnect any hoses that are left connected to spigots. Please notify Marina staff should you have slip maintenance needs or observe any safety concerns.
- The Pinellas County Sheriff's Office encourages the public to notify them when witnessing suspicious or concerning activity. An email to the Harbormaster is also appreciated.
- Per the Marina Rules and Regulations, vessels must be **operable, safe, seaworthy, well-maintained, and presentable condition** at all times.

Happenings

Three pine trees, which died after being attacked by pine bark beetles, have been removed from Edgewater Park. The osprey nest that was in one of the trees has been relocated to another tree close by in the park.

Local bird experts were onsite during the relocation process. They anticipate the osprey will return to the new location during the upcoming nesting season. Two of our resident osprey were also onsite to observe the process, while perched on the marina light poles!
