# **Marina Sightings**

Marine life sightings - Please continue to keep a close eye out for marine life as you proceed with caution through the Marina and the waters of St. Joseph Sound.

**Thank you** to all of you who continue to look out for your fellow slip renters and their vessels. Please feel free to contact us any time you see a vessel that may be at risk.

**Suspicious activity** - Please report any concerns or suspicious activity to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office and/or marina staff right away.

## **Office Matters**

**Extend Absences** - Please notify marina staff if your vessel will be out of the slip for more than a week. The extended absence form can be found on our website and emailed to the Harbormaster.

**Insurance Renewals** - Please be sure to provide the required copy of your insurance declarations page to the Harbormaster's office upon renewal.

**Online Slip Rental Payments** - We continue to encourage everyone to set up payments though your bank's online bill pay system. This will helps to avoid late fees and will keep in-person contact to a minimum during the continued Covid-19 pandemic. The eight digit account number located on your statement is necessary when scheduling payments online with through your bank.

## Happenings

Piling Maintenance - Twenty pilings in various locations throughout the marina basin are scheduled to be replaced beginning in mid-October. Further information will be emailed to slip renters in slips that are included in the project as the dates are finalized.

**Plumbing Repairs** - Water lines along the west wall will be scheduled for replacement in the coming weeks. Look for further information to be emailed to those slip renters that will be affected by temporary interruption in service while these improvements are made.

Olde Bay Café - Renovations are well underway during which time the restaurant has been closed. The staff is looking forward to seeing everyone again very soon, so keep an eye out for their re-opening!

## **Safety First**

**Storm Season** - as we head into the most active period of the storm season, please continue to pay close attention to forecasts, check your lines, and have an action plan in place in the event that severe weather threatens our area.

**Safety Bollards** and parking stops have been installed in front of the slips along the west wall. These are in place to alert drivers when they may be getting too close to the edge of the seawall.

Shore Power Cords should be disconnected from the pedestal and the breakers turned off when not in use. Cords should never be touching the water.

Secure your vessels before leaving the marina and come by to check vessels frequently. Please make sure that anything of value is secured or removed when the vessel is not in use.
