Marina Matters

Storm Season

It's that time of year again as we are entering the peak of the hurricane season. With a system already threatening to head this way, please pay close attention to the following:

- We all watch the weather closely, but don't forget to also <u>CHECK THE TIDES</u>.
- Check all lines for fraying and double them up.
- Check your trailer's tires, brakes and bunks to make sure there are no surprises at the ramp if/when you pull your vessel from the water.
- Monitor all emails from the City and the Marina. Check your spam folder and be sure to add us to your safe sender's list.
- Don't assume that your bilge will continue to work as expected. Two boats nearly sank in the last three weeks. High heat and humidity is detrimental to auto and marine batteries.
- If you are unavailable, assign a responsible party to look after your boat.

Friendly Reminders

- Disconnect hoses from bibs when not in use.
- Bags of trash, cardboard and other large items must be taken to the dumpster (located in the parking lot across from the Harbormaster Office) for disposal. Please do not leave items next to the trash cans for pick up.
