- Proactively shapes the future rather than responding, reacting, or adapting to it.





Strategy vs Operations

Strategic Plan	Operational Plan
Outlines long term goals (3-5 years)	Outlines short term goals (1-2 years)
Focuses on the entire organization.	Focuses on individual department actions and activities.
Pursues the organization's long-term vision and mission.	Supports the Strategic Plan.
Outlines how to get things done.	Details how to get things done.
How the organization is different or what sets us apart (mission, vision, goals).	How the organization can improve operationally.
Internal and external environment.	Internal environment of organization.
Identifies strengths, weakness, opportunities, and threats.	Identifies daily tasks and projects to meet goals.
Looks to define the future.	Looks to accomplish specific projects or actions.
