

## **Dunedin for Youth Fund Scholarships: 2024 Summer Camps**

**Eligibility: Only Dunedin residents may apply for Dunedin for Youth Fund Camp Scholarships.**

- Applications for Dunedin for Youth Fund scholarships will be accepted for children applying for six or more weeks of 2024 summer camp.
  - Scholarships are based on funds available and information turned in by parent/guardian.
  - A maximum of 50% of program cost may be awarded (50% award rarely given)
  - Parent or Legal Guardian must complete the application form entirely, being sure that all requested information is supplied, especially:
    - Specify all weeks of camp (by name) in which you wish to enroll your child.  
(**Applicable camps are:** Pre-K, Kids, Teen, Hammock and Nature Only)
    - XREC is not included.
    - Attach all of the required supporting documentation
- \*\*Applications that are incomplete and/or do not include the supporting documentation will be returned to the applicant and slow down the review process.

### **Enrollment Options:**

- Parents are required to put a **\$25 non-refundable/non-transferable** down payment on ALL desired camp weeks in order to hold spots (Highly Suggested).
- OR**
- If you are unable to put money down on all the weeks desired, you are welcome to submit a scholarship application without enrolling/completing registration paperwork.
    - If you do not put down payments on the weeks we unfortunately cannot guarantee openings or reserve spots for you.
    - Once scholarship is awarded, it shall act in lieu of the \$25 weekly deposit, therefore registering the child in all awarded camp weeks still available.

### **Paying Balances:**

- If enrolling prior to the start of camp, all families will need to pay the balance due for the first two weeks of camp by **May 24<sup>th</sup>**. You will then adhere to the general payment schedule for deferred payments. (See Handbook)
  - Parents applying after camp has started will need to put a \$25 deposit on ALL desired camp weeks if they want their child to begin attending immediately.
- The scholarship approval process may take up to ten business days. Scholarship applicants will be notified via mail or email.
  - Parents/Guardians will be emailed when their account reflects the award given.

**Applications must be filled out completely with supporting documents from all legal guardians attached.** Information will be kept confidential and will be used only for eligibility determination. Scholarships will be awarded based on available funds.

	<b><u>Most recent 8 weeks of pay stubs or current school enrollment documentation</u></b>
	<b><u>2023 tax returns</u></b> listing the child as a dependent, social security number should be blocked out (if not required to file taxes, IRS Tax Return Transcript showing non-filer status must be attached)
	<b><u>Child support documentation</u></b>
	<b><u>Proof of residency</u></b> (i.e. Driver's License)
	<b><u>Government assistance</u></b> received (i.e. SSI, SNAP, EBT, Medicaid)

### **Scholarship Guidelines: Please Initial Each Item**

- If choosing to register after a scholarship determination is made, I understand the Parks & Recreation Department cannot reserve a spot for my child in any camp. It is highly recommended to register as soon scholarship is awarded to ensure spot in desired camps.
- I understand that my child may not miss more than one day of camp per week. A physician's note or legal documentation is required for any absences that exceed the one day per week.
- I understand that my child must be in camp each day from 9am-5pm.
