

ORDINANCE 18-33

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA,
AMENDING SECTION 109-10.1 OF DIVISION 1 OF THE LAND
DEVELOPMENT CODE TO ADD TERM LIMITS FOR MEMBERS
OF THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY; AND PROVIDING FOR
AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.**

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed Section 109-10.1 of Division 1 of the Land Development Code and has recommended that certain revisions are necessary to include term limits for members of the Local Planning Agency; and

WHEREAS, the recommendations of staff have been found meritorious by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has received input from the public at two public hearings.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY
ASSEMBLED:**

Section 1. That Section 109.10.1 of Division 1 of the Land Development Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 109-10.1 - Membership (Local Planning Agency)

The local planning agency shall consist of seven members appointed by the city commission to serve for a term of two years each. Beginning May 1, 2019, appointments for both regular and alternate members shall be for a term of three (3) years. The terms will be staggered so that four members shall serve for terms ending on December 31 in each odd numbered year and the remaining three members shall serve terms ending on December 31 in each even-numbered year. Appointments shall be for terms beginning January 1 or for the remainder of any unexpired term created by resignation or other vacancy. No member, after completing their term and having served three (3) consecutive full terms of two (2) years [two (2) terms of three (3) years if appointed after May 1, 2019], shall be eligible for another term without first having sat off the Local Planning Agency for one (1) year. Any member serving in 2018, who is termed out, may, however, serve one (1) additional term. A member shall receive no compensation for participation as a member of the agency but shall be allowed to receive reimbursement for actual


expenses incurred in the performance of duties. The city commission shall also appoint two alternate members to the board. The alternate members shall be required to have the same qualifications as regular members. The alternate members shall be authorized to participate fully in the business of the board in the absence of a regular member. In addition, there will be one non-voting school district representative appointed by the school board, pursuant to Florida Statutes 163.3174 (1).

If the city commission is unable to fill a vacant board member position with a new board member, it may waive the term limit restriction and reappoint the board member vacating the position for one (1) additional term.


Anyone interested in serving on the Local Planning Agency must complete a City of Dunedin Application for Boards and Committees and attend at least one Local Planning Agency meeting in order to be considered for appointment.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and adoption.
