

RESOLUTION 18-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSES OF REHABILITATION OF LIFT STATION #32; FINDING THAT SUCH A PUBLIC PURPOSE WILL BE SERVED BY APPLYING FOR SUCH FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR ACCEPTANCE OF SUCH GRANTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended to the City Commission that the City apply to the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, a program administered by the Florida Division of Emergency Management for grant funds for the purpose of rehabilitation of Lift Station #32; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that applying for such grant funds and accomplishing the project for which the grant funds are received serves a public purpose and will represent a benefit to the citizens of the City of Dunedin; now, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:


Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to execute the application documents and to do the studies, evaluations, and other matters necessary to apply for a grant to the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the purpose of rehabilitation of Lift Station #32.

Section 2. That the City Commission of the City of Dunedin finds that a public purpose is served by applying for the aforesaid grant and making the necessary expenditures and commitments to submit such an application


Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the grant if it is awarded on substantially the same terms and in the amount reflected in the application. In the event that there is a material difference in the terms of the grant, or in the amount of the grant awarded to the City, acceptance of the grant will be by motion of the City Commission.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
