

RESOLUTION 19-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 18-11 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE ORDINANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE TO EXTEND THE DATE IN WHICH THE COMMITTEE IS TO ISSUE ITS REPORT TO THE CITY COMMISSION; AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution 18-11, on July 26, 2018 to authorize the establishment of an Ordinance Review Committee to review the City of Dunedin Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 18-11 provided that the Ordinance Review Committee would continue in its existence and submit its recommendations to the City Commission within 180 days of the appointment of the Committee, which will expire on March 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission appointed Ordinance Review Committee members on September 4, 2018 which would continue in its existence to submit its recommendations to the City Commission within 180 days, which will expire on March 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 19-10 will amend the time the report is due, from 180 days to 270 days, which means it will expire on June 3, 2019; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY ASSEMBLED:


Section 1. That Section 3 of Resolution 18-11 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The committee shall continue in existence until such time as it submits its recommendations to the City Commission,

following its review of the City Ordinances. Such report shall be submitted to the City Commission not later than ~~one hundred and eighty (180)~~ two hundred Seventy (270) days from the date that such members have been appointed by motion or ballot of the City Commission.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and adoption.
