


RESOLUTION 20-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROACH THE PINELLAS COUNTY FIRE AND EMS ADMINISTRATION TO PROVIDE A RESCUE UNIT IN THE FY21 BUDGET FOR FIRE STATION 60; FINDING THAT A PUBLIC PURPOSE WILL BE SERVED BY APPLYING FOR SUCH UNIT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.



WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended to the City Commission that the City contact the Pinellas County Fire and EMS Administration and request the provision of a rescue unit for Fire Station 60 in its FY21 budget; and

WHEREAS, County Resolution 09-37 provides the authority for the City Manager to apply for such acquisition, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that obtaining such equipment serves a public purpose and will represent a benefit to the citizens of Dunedin; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY ASSEMBLED:


Section 1. That the City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to contact the Pinellas County Fire and EMS Administration and request the provision of a rescue unit for Fire Station 60 in the County's FY21 budget.

Section 2. That the City Commission of the City of Dunedin finds that a public purpose is served by applying for such equipment.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption
