Ready For 100% Clean Energy

The City of Dunedin has committed to clean renewable energy! Dunedin plans to have internal city operations running on 100% clean renewable energy by 2035 and the entire surrounding city to be the same by 2050. Dunedin is working with Duke Energy, surrounding municipalities and organizations, like Sierra Club, to make this goal become a reality.

Staff, the Committee on Environmental Quality, local partners and residents are currently writing Dunedin's Resilient Environmental Action Master Plan (DREAM). This plan will encompass many goals and programs, including the Ready For 100 plan. To get involved contact Natalie Gass.
