

Dunedin Marina Dredging Project

Weekly Updates - Week #1 (5/1/20)

We are pleased to bring you the first of the weekly updates each Friday regarding the dredging project.

- As a reminder, the dredging contractor anticipates mobilizing and occupying portions of the marina premises beginning the week of May 25. Dredging operations will begin June 1st.
- Thank you to everyone who has assisted with this large undertaking by making arrangements to remove your vessels from the marina basin. We continue to get communications each day from slip renters that have secured slips at other marinas. Local marina support for our slip renters has been tremendous and we will be reaching out to them to express our gratitude.
- We have also received approval for the use of the church parking lot across the street from the marina for the storage of up to 20 boats on trailers. Please let us know as soon as possible if you are interested in storing your vessel at this lot. The City will be installing fencing, as well as a locked gate for security and only vessel owners will have access. Anyone utilizing this option must complete a hold harmless agreement prior to arrival. Please contact the Harbormaster's office for further details.
- We are also working on needed maintenance and repairs to Dock A that will begin soon. These improvements are for safety and are not the future reconstruction of Dock A currently anticipated. For those slip renters, we ask that prior to vacating your slip, please leave your dock box open or furnish marina staff with a key/code so that we can move it when the time comes. Every dock box will be returned to its proper place on the dock.
- If you have not yet contacted us with your plan for your vessel, please do so as soon as possible. We are tracking vessels and planning accordingly so that we can proceed as efficiently as possible once the dredge begins. The fewer vessels that remain in the marina, the smoother the entire project will proceed.
- Again, for those who vacate any time during this month you will not be charged slip rent for May. You will also receive one additional month rent waiver when you return upon completion of the project. Also, the boat ramp is closing to the general public on May 8th to assist with the removal process. You will have ramp access until May 29th to remove your vessel. Once the project commences, it is an active construction zone and access to the Marina is prohibited without coordinated permission through Marina staff.
