

Dunedin Marina Dredging Project

Weekly Updates - Week #2 (5/8/20)

We are pleased to bring you this week's update regarding the dredging project:

- **Project Dates** - As a reminder, the dredging contractor anticipates mobilizing and occupying portions of the marina premises beginning the week of May 25. Dredging operations will begin June 1st.
- **Trailer Storage** - There is still space available at the Church of the Good Shepard parking lot across the street for those who are in need of a location to store their vessels on a trailer. Please call the office at 727-298-3030 or reply to this email to reserve a space.
- **Boat Ramp** - The boat ramp will be closed to the general public and will be available exclusively to slip renters from Saturday, May 9th through Friday, May 29th. This is to assist the process of those who will be removing their vessels by trailer.
- **Dock A** – The decking on Dock A is scheduled to be replaced. This work will be done during the same time as the dredge to minimize the impact to our slip renters. We ask for these slip renters to please leave your key/code with marina staff or leave your dock box open. Any items not able to be stored inside of your dock box should be removed, with the exception of hoses, lines, and power cords.
- **West Wall Access** - As the Pinellas County beaches are now open, the barricades blocking the road to the west side of the marina have been removed. Owners now have improved access to their vessels in order to prepare for vacating the marina. This access will be closed beginning on June 1st, along with the entire marina and parking lot.
- **Remaining Vessels** – We will be contacting those remaining in the marina next week with your temporary slip assignments as well as with instructions and timelines regarding the movement of vessels.

The response from slip renters willing to help expedite this project has been amazing. We would like to thank all of you for your help, support and cooperation with preparing for the task ahead. Marina staff remains available to assist however we can help.
