

Dunedin Marina Dredging Project

Weekly Updates - Week #3 (5/15/20)

We are pleased to bring you this week's update regarding the dredging project:

- **Project Dates** - The dredging contractor is on schedule to begin occupying portions of the marina premises beginning the week of May 25th. The marina will be closed beginning on May 30th. This will include the west wall, Boat Club, Pram Shed and east parking lot. Dredging operations will begin June 1st.
- **Trailer Storage** – A temporary fence has been installed at the Church of the Good Shepard parking lot. The vessels stored here will be behind a locked gate only accessible by slip renters and marina staff. Marina slip renters using this lot to store their vessels will be given the combination and will have access 7 days a week from 7 a.m. until 9 p.m. Space is limited, so anyone interested in using this lot for vessel storage should call the Harbormaster office at 727-298-3030, or reply to this email to reserve a space.
- **Boat Ramp** - The boat ramp is closed to the general public, but will remain available to slip renters through Friday, May 29th in order to assist in the process for those who will be removing their vessels by trailer.
- **Dock A** – An email was sent out Wednesday with an update on this project to the Marina Advisory Committee and the slip renters on Dock A (see attachment for details). Dock A remains on the schedule for the replacement of all of the dock boards with new wood (pending structural analysis) as well as new pedestals in effort to defer full reconstruction to a preferred time. This work will be done during the same time as the dredge to minimize the impact to our slip renters. We ask for these slip renters to please leave your key/code with marina staff or leave your dock box open. Any items not able to be stored inside of your dock box should be removed, with the exception of hoses, lines, and power cords.
- **Vessels remaining in Marina during Dredge** – We will be contacting owners whose vessels will be remaining in the marina as soon as your temporary slip has been vacated. You will then be able to move and secure your vessel.

Again, we would like to thank all of you for your help, support and cooperation with preparing for the task ahead. Marina staff remains available to assist in any way possible.
