

Dunedin Marina Dredging Project

Weekly Updates - Week #7 (6/12/20)

The dredging project is proceeding through Phase 1 with no unexpected delays to date. The phasing map is attached for your reference so that you can follow along with the progress as you receive updates. The entire marina continues to be a construction zone including the beach area, west wall, Boat Club, Pram Shed and east parking lot.

- **Dredging Process** - Surveys are completed as areas are dredged in order to confirm that the proper amount of sediment is being removed. The crews will revisit areas as deemed necessary by the survey results if further sediment removal is required. Once a phase is thought to be completed, the area will be left to settle for 5-10 days prior to performing another survey. Assuming that those survey results show that the dredging has been completed in accordance with the contractual obligations, we will begin to shuffle the vessels that have remained in the marina in order to prepare for the next phase. Vessels that have vacated the marina will only be permitted to return once the entire project is completed.
- **Marina Advisory Committee Meeting** - The MAC Meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 15th at 5:15 p.m. Due to Covid-19, the meeting will be held virtually on Zoom. The agenda for this public meeting is attached for your convenience and includes a link for anyone interested in joining.
- **Vessels Remaining in the Marina** - Approximately half of the vessels remaining in the marina have been checked on by their owners since the dredging began. We encourage all of you to take advantage of scheduled group visits as often as you like in order to be confident that your vessels are secure. If you have not been receiving the emails for these scheduled visits, please call the office for further information. **Access will only be allowed via the Harbormaster and only after the dredging activity has stopped for the day.** No access will be granted while crews are working and dredging is active.
 - **Returning of Vessels to Original Slips** – As each Phase nears completion, we will contact the owners of vessels remaining in the marina to provide them with information regarding moving the vessel back to its original slip.
 - **Movement of Vessels between Dredge Phases** – If your vessel is remaining in the Marina during the dredge, **it is the responsibility of the boat owner to move their vessel when needed.** You will be provided the required window of time to move your vessel when work is being done in that area. This notice will be provided a few days in advance. Marina staff will not move any vessels, unless the owner fails to do so. If you feel you may not be available for any reason during this time, it is your

responsibility designate someone to move it on your behalf. **Please read paragraph 10 of your Revocable Use Agreement for further detail.**

- **Day Dock Access** – Day Dock access on the pier is limited to our slip renters who have anchored in the sound, and for our commercial renters who are picking up and dropping off customers. Signage has been placed at the docks to restrict the day dock usage for those two purposes only. However, marina staff will not be onsite at all times to enforce those instructions.
- **Dock A** - The structural analysis of Dock A was completed on Tuesday, June 2nd. We are currently awaiting the results in a report that will be sent to our Engineering Department upon receipt.
