

ORDINANCE 20-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 74-111. OF CHAPTER 74 OF THE DUNEDIN CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD THE DEFINITIONS OF E-BIKE, HOVERBOARD AND SEGWAY AND AMEND THE DEFINITIONS OF RIDER AND VEHICLE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2018 the Dunedin City Commission adopted Resolution 18-11 to establish an Ordinance Review Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance Review Committee held ten (10) meetings between October 1, 2018 and December 11, 2019 to review and discuss twenty-three (23) Chapters of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the recommendations regarding proposed amendments to the Dunedin Code of Ordinances were submitted to the City Commission with the ORC Report; and

WHEREAS, certain recommendations of the Ordinance Review Committee have been found meritorious by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has received input from the public at two public hearings.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. That the definitions for *E-bike, Hoverboard and Segway* be added to Section 74-111 of Chapter 74 and shall read as follows:

E-bike means a bicycle that can be run on electric power as well as by pedaling.

Hoverboard means a motorized personal vehicle consisting of a platform for the feet mounted on two wheels and controlled by the way the rider distributes their weight.

Segway means a two-wheeled motorized personal vehicle consisting of a platform for the feet mounted above an axle and an upright post surmounted by handles, controlled by the way the rider distributes their weight.

Section 2. That the definitions for *Rider* and *Vehicle* in Section 74.111. of Chapter 74 are amended to read as follows:

Rider means a person conveying himself by scooter, skateboard, e-bike, hoverboard or segway.

Vehicle means skates, skateboards, scooters, e-bikes, hoverboards, segways or other similar devices.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and adoption.
