MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA, HELD AT THE CITY
HALL IN SAID CITY ON THE 21st DAY OF FEBRUARY,
1966, at 7:00 O'CLOCK, P. M.

On the 21st day of February, 1966, the Commissioners of the
City of Dunedin, Florida, met in the City Hall in said City in
regular session. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 o'clock
P. M. by GERALD S. REHM, Mayor-Commissioner, and on the roll call
the following members of the Commission were found to be present:

The following resolution was introduced by Mr. Emil O.
Lindner, who moved its adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 65-13

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR A HOUSING
AUTHORITY IN THE CITY OF DUNEDIN, FLORIDA.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DUNEDIN,
FLORIDA, IN SESSION DULY AND REGULARLY ASSEMBLED:

That the Commission of the City of Dunedin, Florida, hereby
determines, finds and declares in pursuance of the "Housing
Authorities Law" of the State of Florida, that:

1. Insanitary and unsafe inhabited dwelling accomodations
exist in the City of Dunedin, Florida; and
2. There is a shortage of safe and sanitary dwelling
accommodations in the City of Dunedin, Florida, available to
families of low income at rentals they can afford; and
3. There is need for a housing authority in the City of

Dunedin, Florida.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Mayor-Commissioner of the City of Dunedin, Florida, be promptly notified of the adoption of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That this resolution shall be effective immediately.

The motion to adopt said resolution was seconded by Mr. Owens, and upon roll call vote the following voted Aye: Commissioner Emil O. Lindner; Commissioner Vivien Rogers; Commissioner Albert J. Snook; Commissioner James B. Owens; Mayor-Commissioner Gerald S. Rehm.

Thereupon the Mayor-Commissioner declared said resolution duly adopted and passed.

The Mayor-Commissioner of the City of Dunedin being present at the meeting was thereupon notified of the adoption of the said resolution.

After being notified of the adoption of the Resolution declaring the need for a Housing Authority in the City of Dunedin, Florida, the Mayor appointed the five persons hereinafter named to serve as Commissions of the Dunedin Housing Authority and designated John L. Young as the first Chairman.

S. A. Davis 4 years

William A. Dexter, Jr. 4 years

A. A. Maynard 2 years

C. Townsend Scanlan 3 years

John L. Young 1 year

After considering the appointment of the Commissioners and the designation of the first Chairman, the following Resolution was introduced by Emil O. Lindner and read in full.

RESOLUTION NO. 65-14

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE DUNEDIN HOUSING AUTHORITY AND DESIGNATION OF THE FIRST CHAIRMAN.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Gerald S. Rehm, Mayor-Commissioner of the City of Dunedin, Florida, has appointed S. A. Davis, William A. Dexter, Jr., A. A. Maynard, C. Townsend Scanlan, and John L. Young, as Commissioners of the Dunedin Housing Authority and has designated John L. Young as first Chairman,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Dunedin, Florida, in session duly and regularly assembled:

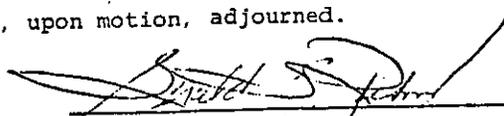
1. That the appointment of S. A. Davis, William A. Dexter, Jr., A. A. Maynard, C. Townsend Scanlan and John L. Young, as Commissioners of the Dunedin Housing Authority and the designation of John L. Young as the first Chairman, are hereby confirmed and approved.

Nays: None.

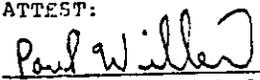
The Mayor-Commissioner declared the Resolution passed as Resolution No. 65-14.
